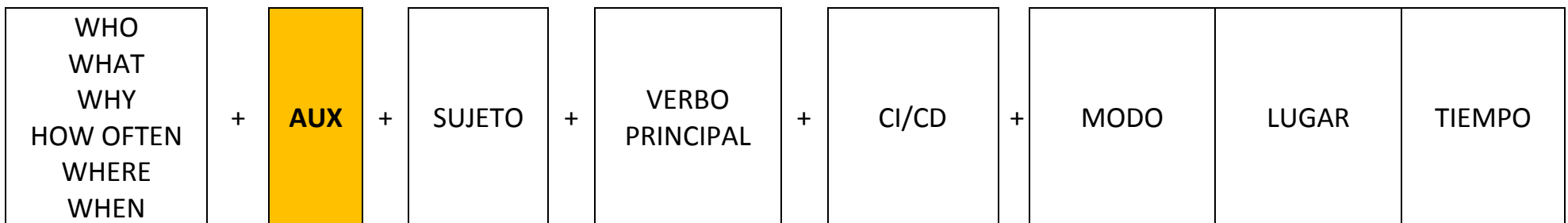


Past simple	It's been (2 weeks) since (Susan) <b>last</b> + past simple (ed/II columna)
	I <b>started</b> smoking 5 months <b>ago</b> .
Present Perfect	Present Perfect + NEVER+ BEFORE I've never seen an Elephant before.
Despite In spite of	<b>The fact that</b> + frase complete (sujeto + verbo...)

→ Present Perfect	Presente perfecto en negative con "for" Susan hasn't come to school for 2 weeks.
→ Present Perfect continuous	I've been Smoking for 5 months.
→ Present Perfect	It is the first time + PRESENTE PERFECTO It is the first time I've seen an elephant
→ Although	Sujeto+ verbo+ complementos....

So + adjetivo + that clause	Such a+ adj+ noun+ that clause
Because	Since/As
Too + adjetivo	NOT + adjetivo contrario+ ENOUGH
Comparativo de superioridad	Negar el comparativo de igualdad

→	It was a film so boring that I fell asleep. It was such a boring film that I fell asleep
→	I am tired because I've been working all day. As/Since I've been working all day I'm tired.
→	This car is too expensive for me. This car is not cheap enough for me.
→	My house is bigger than yours. Your house is not so big as mine.
